### **Day 3 Tue March 24 - Venice**

Your morning tour of Venice is on foot and will highlight the Basilica of St. Mark St. & Mark's Square, the largest square in the city and the site of many government buildings; the Golden Basilica of San Marco, known for the great mosaics that depict the Old and New Testament of the Bible, walk through the canals until we reach the famous Bridge of Sighs. Afternoon at leisure or enjoy a optional Gondola ride through the Venetian canals. (B)

### **Day 4 Wed March 25 - Venice - Bologna - Florence**

This morning depart Venice driving through the Veneto region. Our first stop will be Bologna, area famous for Parmigiano Reggiano cheese, Italy's "food basket" prosciutto di Parma, risotto, Barilla pasta, Parmigiano Reggiano cheese & Balsamic Vinegar. Enjoy Bologna and time for lunch. In the afternoon Check in at your hotel in Florence, followed by dinner. (B,D)

### **Day 5 Thu March 26 - Florence**

Morning tour of Florence, the Cradle of Renaissance and home of Michelangelo, we start from the Accademia Gallery to see Michelangelo's original "David" statue, we then continue to Giotto's Bell Tower, the Baptistry with its "Gates of Paradise" doors and Signoria Square, our tour ends on Santa Croce square. Afternoon is free to explore and learn more about Florence. (B)

### **Day 6 Fri March 27 - Siena - San Gimignano - Florence**

Morning departure for Siena, famous for "Il Palio" the bareback horse race & city of Saint Catherine, visit the church of San Domenico and piazza del campo. Today enjoy a wine tasting session followed by lunch at a local winery. In the afternoon we explore San Gimignano one of Italy's best preserved medieval villages. Time at leisure for shopping. This evening enjoy dinner on your own in Florence. (B,L)

**Day 7 Sat March 28 - Florence - Orvieto - Rome**

Enjoy the Umbrian countryside on our way to Rome. En route we stop in Orvieto ancient Etruscan settlement also famous for the 14th century Cathedral built to commemorate the Eucharistic Miracle of Bolsena. In the afternoon check in at your hotel in Rome, in time to a short walk to Spanish Steps & Trevi Fountain followed by evening at leisure to dine on own in the Eternal City. (B)

**Day 8 Sun March 29 - Rome**

Palm Sunday morning mass. After mass discover the Roman Forum, with a stop at the Colosseum - a testament to the greatness of Rome's past. Continue your

day tour by viewing the Arch of Constantine, Circus Maximus, the Great Synagogue, Isola Tiberina and Castel Sant'Angelo. Evening will be at leisure today. (B)

**Day 9 Mon March 30 - Vatican Museums**

This morning experience a very special guided tour of the priceless collection of art and treasures in the Sistine Chapel and Vatican Museum. You will be amazed by the beautiful wall frescoes created by Michelangelo, Perugino and Botticelli. The unique ceiling of the Sistine Chapel is surely one of Michelangelo's greatest achievements. Continue to St. Peter's Basilica, the largest church in the Christian world, built over the tomb of St. Peter. Rest of the day at leisure to explore the eternal city on your own. Tonight enjoy a traditional farewell dinner with wine in a lovely Roman restaurant. (B,D)
