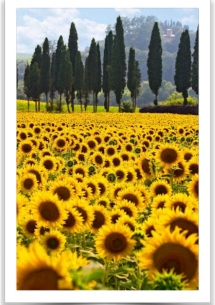

Day 1 Sun Oct 18 - Philadelphia - Venice

Depart the USA. Flight to Venice. Meals and refreshments served on board.

Day 2 Mon Oct 19 - Venice Morning arrival into Venice Airport *Look for **ROMA TRAVEL** sign after clearing Customs/Immigration and collecting luggage follow exit and you'll be met and transferred to your hotel by water taxi. The balance of the day is at leisure. In the afternoon meet group members for a brief presentation of daily activities. This evening enjoy a welcome dinner at a local restaurant. (D)

2 nights Venice: Hotel Avani Rio Novo Venice / Calle Larga Ragusei, 3489/

Day 3 Tue Oct 20 - Venice Your morning tour of Venice is on foot and will highlight the Basilica of St. Mark St. & Mark's Square, the largest square in the city and the site of many government buildings; the Golden Basilica of San Marco, known for the great mosaics that depict the Old and New Testament of the Bible, walk through the canals until we reach the famous Bridge of Sighs. Afternoon at leisure or enjoy a optional Gondola ride through the Venetian canals. (B)

Day 4 Wed Oct 21 - Venice - Bologna - Florence This morning depart Venice driving through the Veneto region. Our first stop will be Bologna, area famous for Parmigiano Reggiano cheese, Italy's "food basket" prosciutto di Parma, risotto, Barilla pasta, Parmigiano Reggiano cheese & Balsamic Vinegar. Enjoy Bologna and time for lunch. In the afternoon Check in at your hotel in Florence, followed by dinner. (B,D)

3 nights Tuscany Florence: Hotel Roma - Firenze / Piazza di Santa Maria

Day 5 Thu Oct 22 - Florence

Morning tour of Florence, the Cradle of Renaissance and home of Michelangelo, we start from the **Accademia** Gallery to see Michelangelo's original "David" statue, we then continue to Giotto's Bell Tower, the Baptistry with its "Gates of Paradise" doors and Signoria Square, our tour ends on Santa Croce square. Afternoon is free to explore and learn more about Florence. (B)

Day 6 Fri Oct 23 - Siena - San Gimignano - Florence Morning departure for Siena, famous for "Il Palio" the bareback horse race & city of Saint Catherine, visit the church of San Domenico and piazza del campo. Today enjoy a wine tasting session followed by lunch at a local winery. In the afternoon we explore San Gimignano one of Italy's best preserved medieval villages. Time at leisure for shopping. This evening enjoy dinner on your own in Florence. (B,L)



Day 7 Sat Oct 24 - Florence - Orvieto - Sorrento Enjoy the Umbrian countryside on our way to Sorrento. En route we stop in Orvieto ancient Etruscan settlement also famous for the 14th century Cathedral built to commemorate the Eucharistic Miracle of Bolsena. Our journey continues following the Apennine Mountains through Montecassino and bay of Naples to Sorrento. Late afternoon check into your hotel. Tonight enjoy a relaxing dinner at your hotel. **(B,D)**

Day 8 Sun Oct 25 - Capri - Sorrento This morning take a fast ferry across the Bay of Naples to the charming island of Capri. Enjoy the breathtaking sights of this picturesque island. Once there, you'll have time to explore on your own. You may want to take a chair-lift to capture the natural wonder and views of the colorful waters from Anacapri or just take a leisurely stroll along the winding lanes while enjoying a gelato. The choice is yours. Return to Sorrento in the afternoon for an evening at leisure. **(B)**

Day 9 Mon Oct 26 - Amalfi Coast - Sorrento In the morning explore the Amalfi Coast, a gorgeous stretch of rugged coastline along the Mediterranean. Stop to explore some of the scenic small towns Positano, along the scenic coastal rive such as Amalfi the Italy most powerful Marine Capital. Time at leisure for lunch. In the afternoon return to Sorrento, evening at leisure to experience on your own. **(B)**

Day 10 Tue Oct 27 - Sorrento - Pompei - Rome Depart for Rome, en route we visit the World Heritage site of Pompeii, a city frozen in time after a volcanic eruption in 79 AD. Learn about the city's rediscovery in 1748 and excavation on a guided tour of this archaeological treasure. Enjoy a local Neapolitan Pizza lunch. In the afternoon check in at your hotel in Rome, in time to experience a taste of Rome after a short walk to Spanish Steps & Trevi Fountain, a great introduction to the exciting Roman Dolce Vita **(B,L)**

Day 11 Wed Oct 28 - Papal Audience - Imperial Rome Morning PAPAN AUDIENCE (subject to the Holy Father's official Papal Calendar). In the afternoon proceed to the Roman Forum, with a stop at the Colosseum - a testament to the greatness of Rome's past. Continue your day tour by viewing the Arch of Constantine, Circus Maximus, the Great Synagogue, Isola Tiberina and Castel Sant'Angelo. Enjoy the rest of the day to explore Rome on your own.**(B)**

Day 12 Thu Oct 29 - Vatican Museums This morning experience a very special guided tour of the priceless collection of art and treasures in the Sistine Chapel and Vatican Museum (Subject to Availability and Vatican event schedules). You will be amazed by the beautiful wall frescoes created by Michelangelo, Perugino and Botticelli. Continue to St. Peter's Basilica, the largest church in the Christian world, built over the tomb of St. Peter. Tonight enjoy Rome with a traditional farewell dinner with wine in a lovely Roman restaurant. **(B,D)**

Day 13 Fri Oct 30 - DEPARTURE Morning transfer to Rome Fiumicino airport for your return flight home. **(B)**
